MPOA: Chickee Hut Rules and Regulations

Please read the following Chickee Hut Reservation Rules carefully. Failure to comply with one or more of these rules may result in loss of a portion or all of your security deposit. Please check next to each of the Rules below to confirm your agreement.

Note: Your reservation is not final until your MPOA membership is confirmed and reviewed by the Board for approval, if applicable.

- MPOA member/reservation holder is responsible for informing guests of all park policies and is responsible for guest compliance with all park rules.
- All trash, recycling, and event materials must be fully removed from the park. All renters are required to bring their own large bags and remove all trash. Failure to do so will result in the loss of deposit.
- All groups of 51 or more are required to contract with the city for trash removal. City sets their fees and service.
- Chickee Hut function guest parking is provided on the grass overflow parking area. This will hold between 7-10 non-member cars.
- Carpooling and off-site parking with shuttle vehicle(s) is(are) encouraged for invited guests but required for non-member vehicles that would exceed the 7-10 allotted parking spaces on the grass.
- Functions that are open to or attract the general public are not permitted.
- Electricity service is not available.
- Staking or digging into the ground is not permitted
- Picnic tables are not to be removed from under the Chickee. If there is a need to move them within the Chickee Hut, they must be replaced before the area is considered cleaned and packed up. Failure will result in loss of deposit.
- Vendor(s) hired for services must be entirely self-contained. Member must secure a City permit if required (i.e. food trucks), and vendor name(s), certificate of license, and certificate of insurance must be submitted to the MPOA at least 7 days prior.
- Inflatables, balloons, glitter, paintball guns, and pets/domesticated animals are not permitted at the Beach Park. Styrofoam, plastic straws, and other environmentally unfriendly materials are STRONGLY discouraged.
- Grills, torches, candles, gas-fueled lanterns, fireworks, tiki torches, Chinese lanterns (also called wish lanterns and flying lanterns), and open flames are not permitted.
- Amplified music is not permitted.
- Member must be continuously present during the entire function and must check-in at beginning and check-out at end of the function with the Park Attendant on duty
- Security deposit return will be reduced or revoked if one or more of the rules and regulations are violated. Member is liable for any damages exceeding the amount of the deposit.
- The reservation deposit will be frozen until the Chickee Committee has had a chance to view the area or speak to Park Attendants and release deposit.
